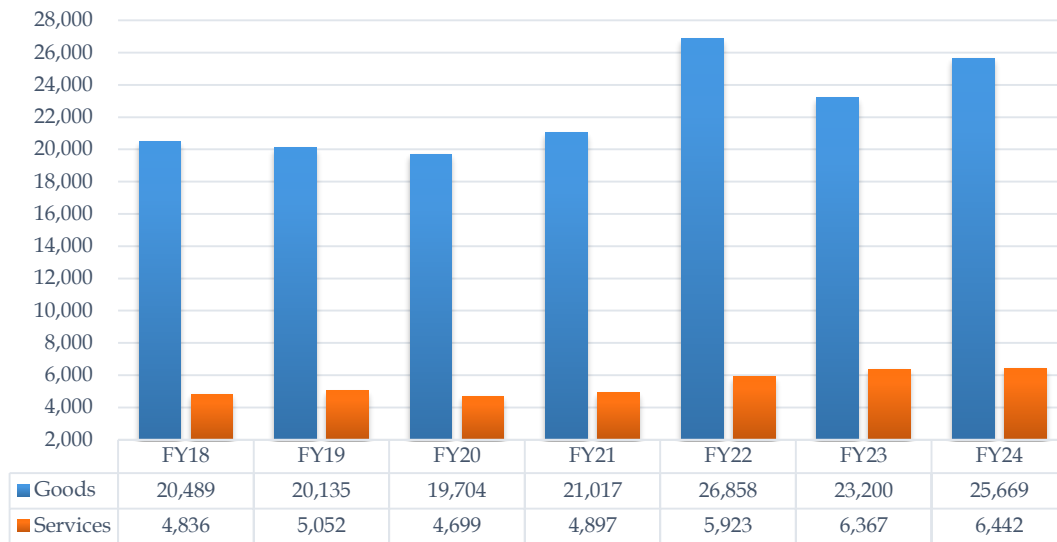

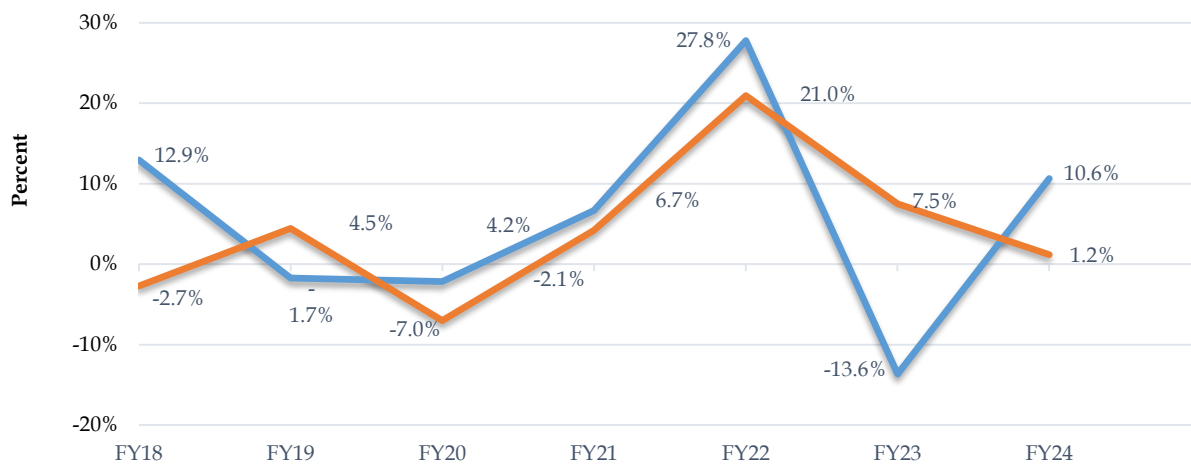

**Growth in Export of Goods and Services during July-Apr****Figure 2**

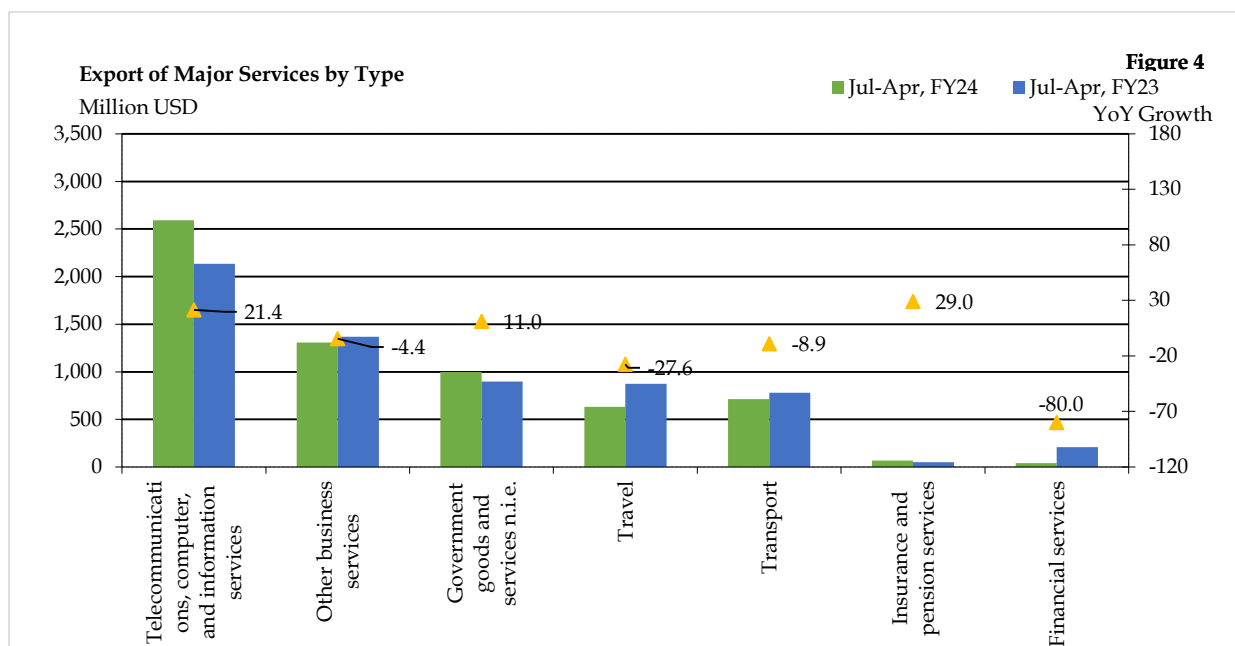
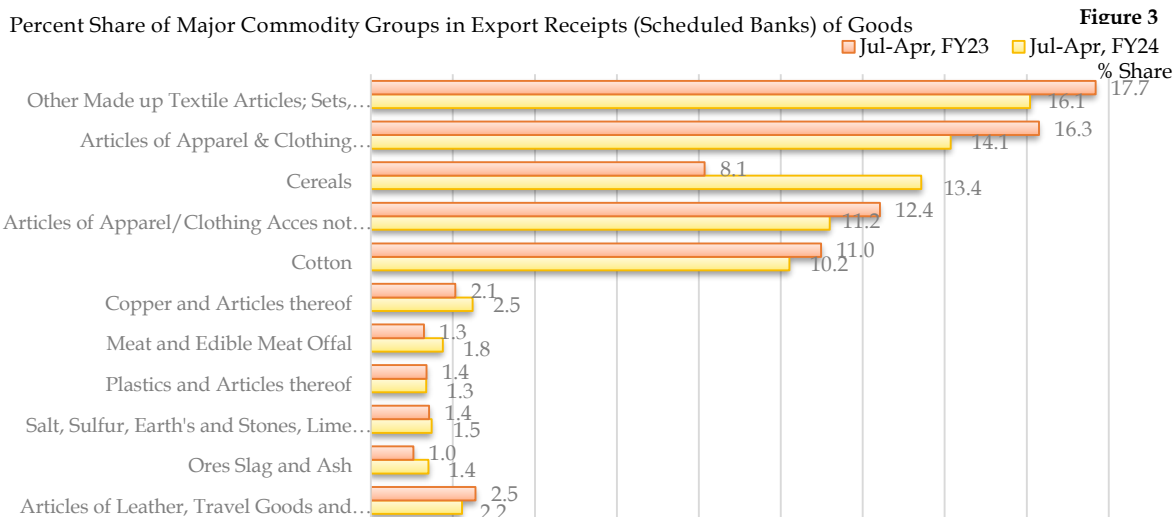

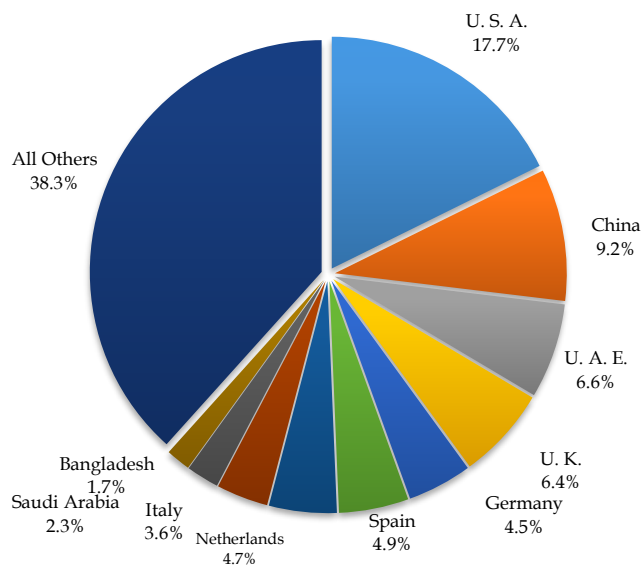

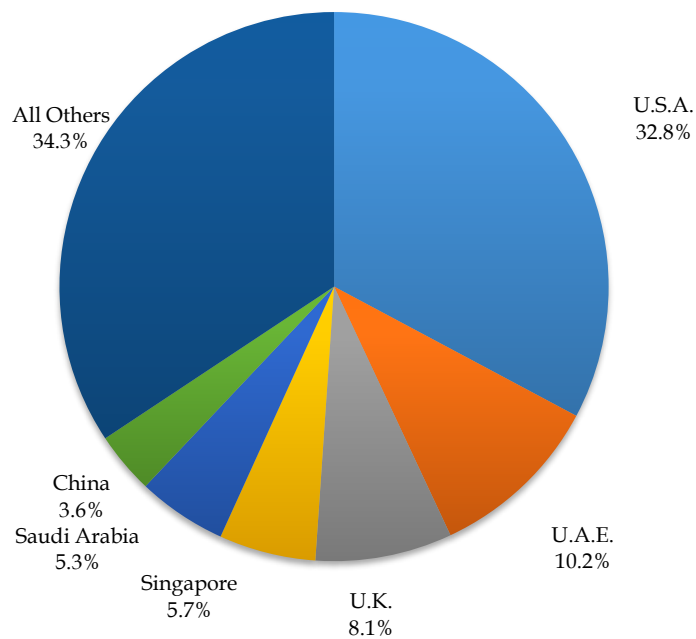
Percent share of Major Countries in Export Receipts of Goods during July-April, FY24

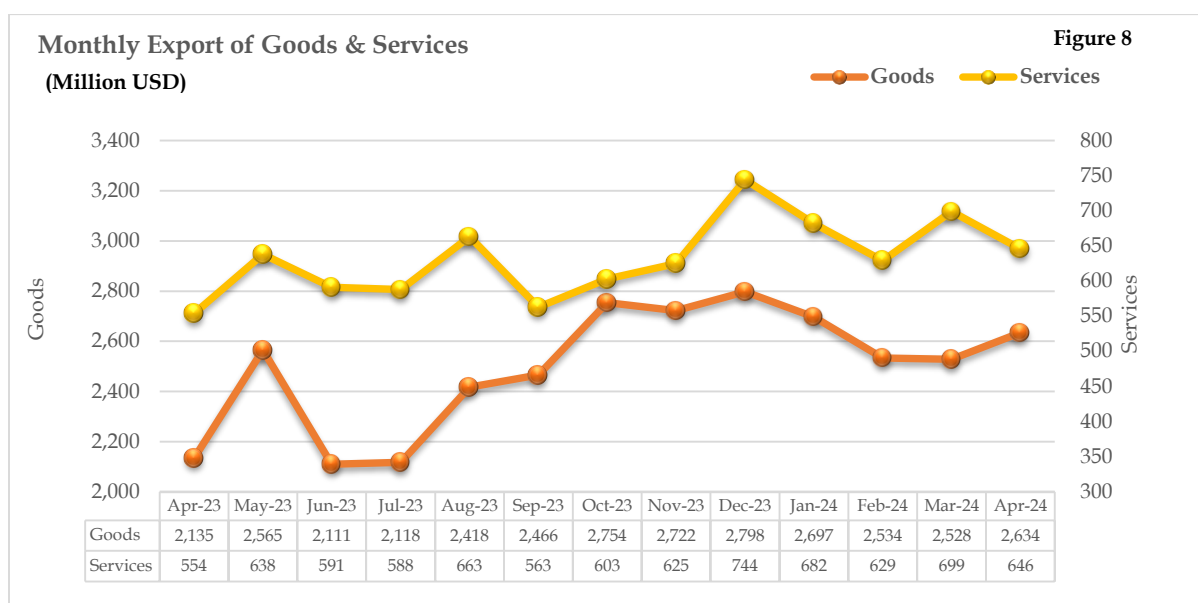
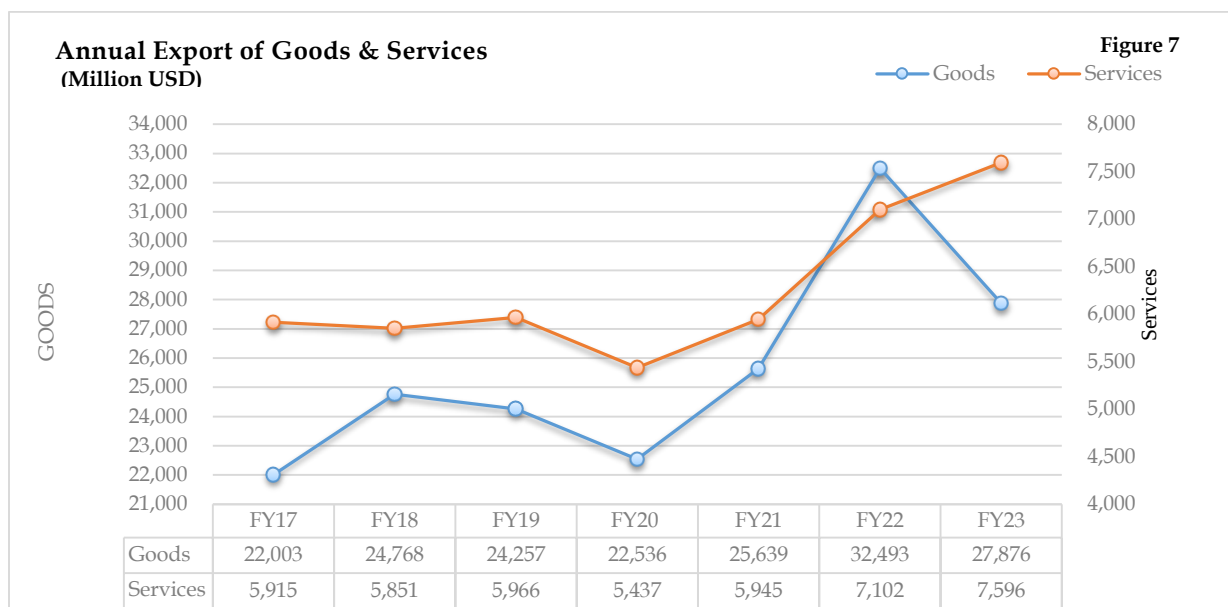
