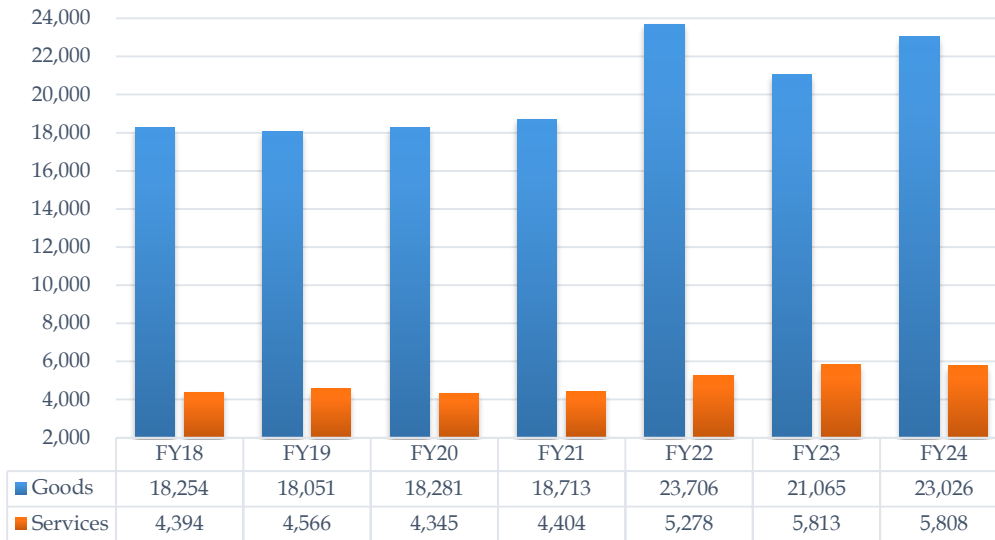

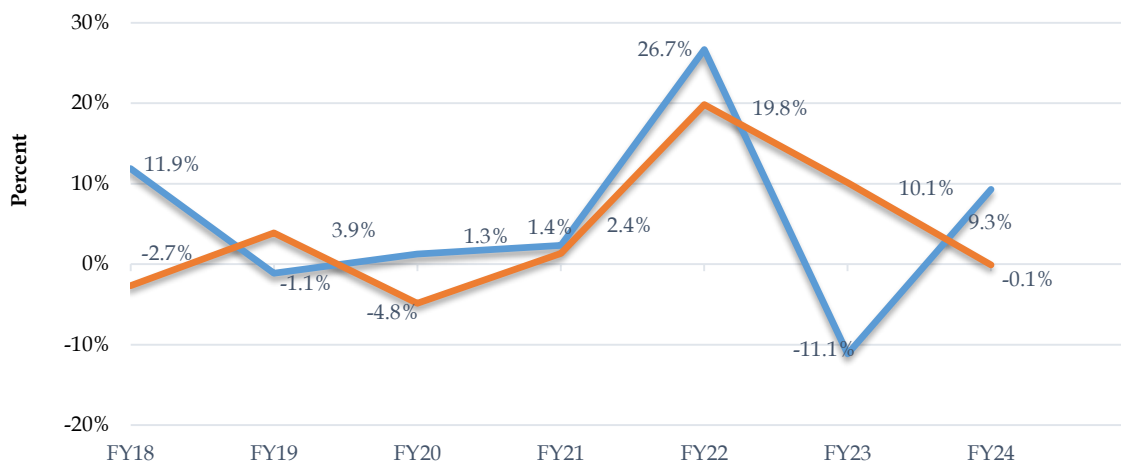

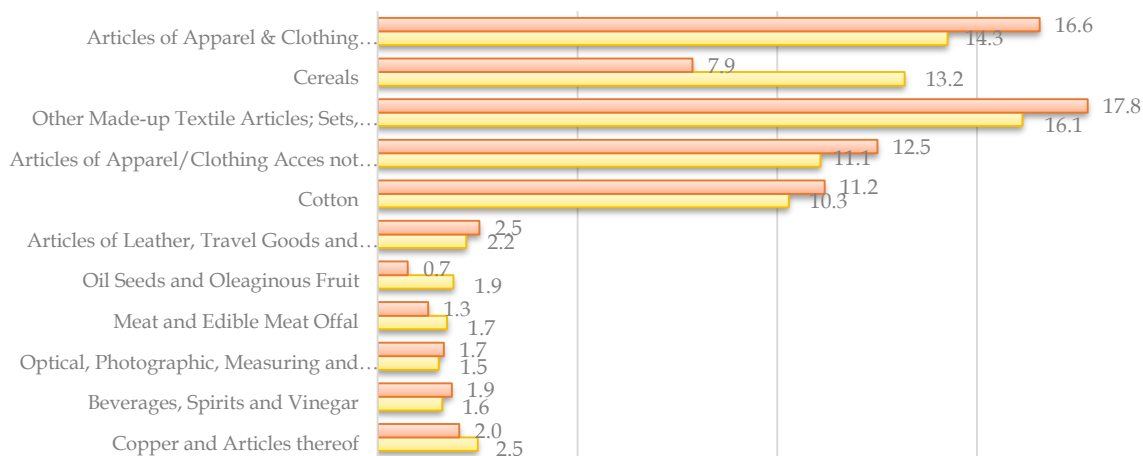

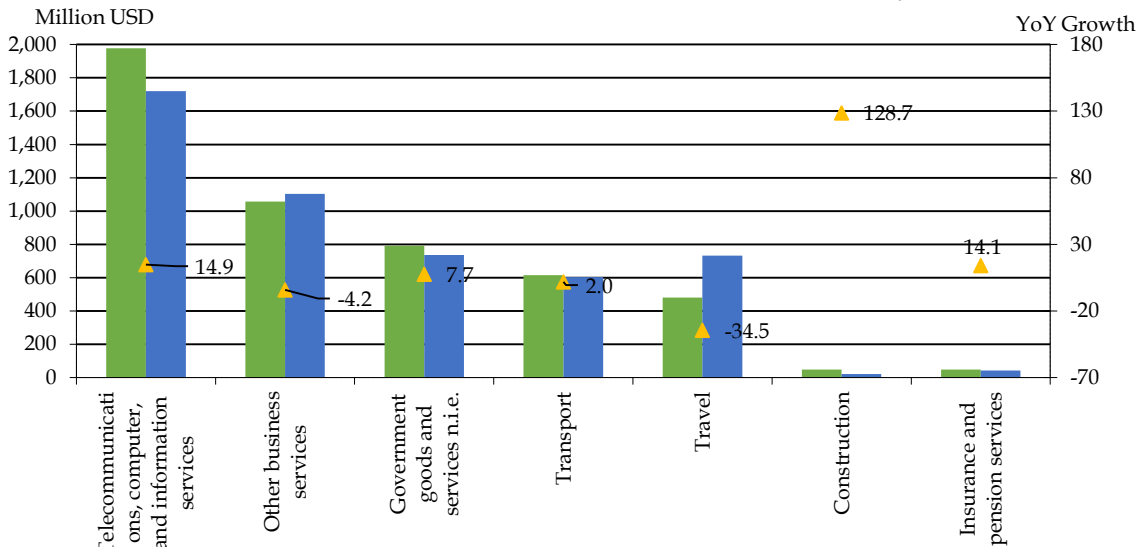

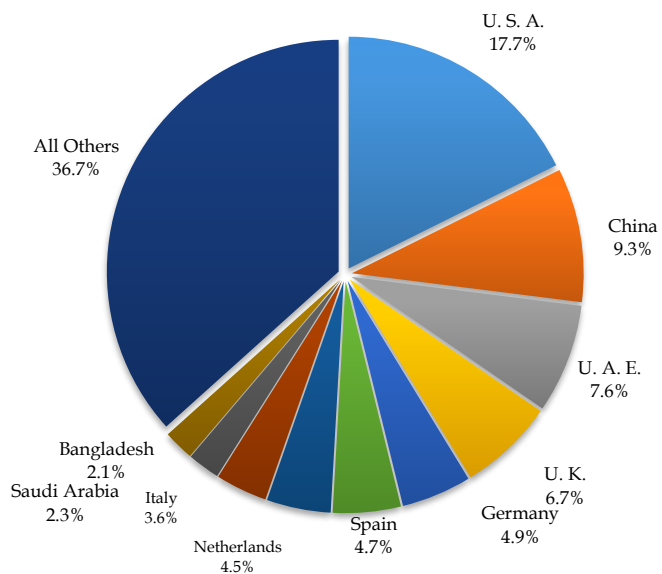

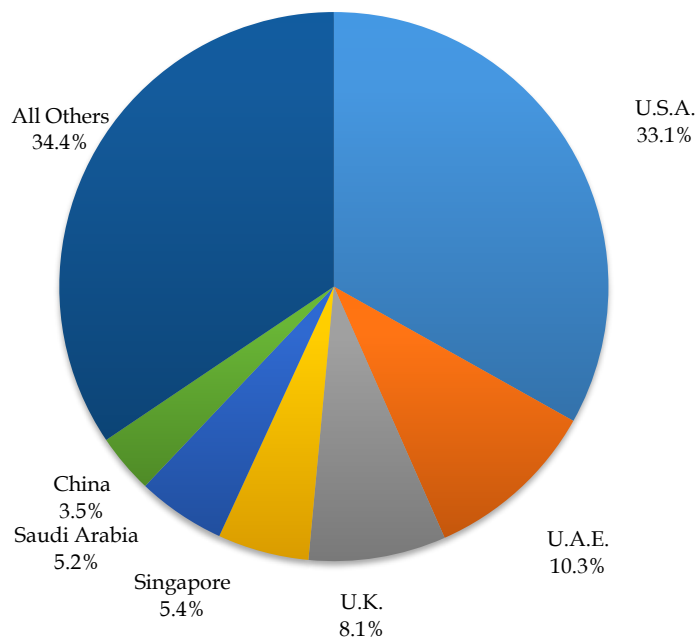
Percent share of Major Countries in Export Receipts of Goods during July-March, FY24

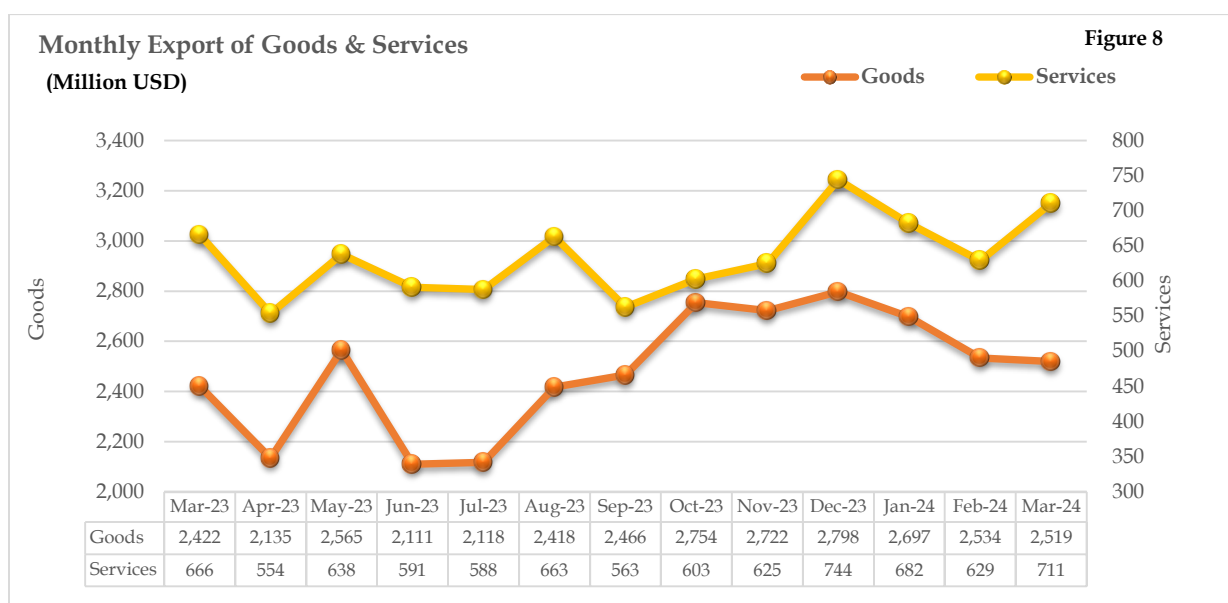
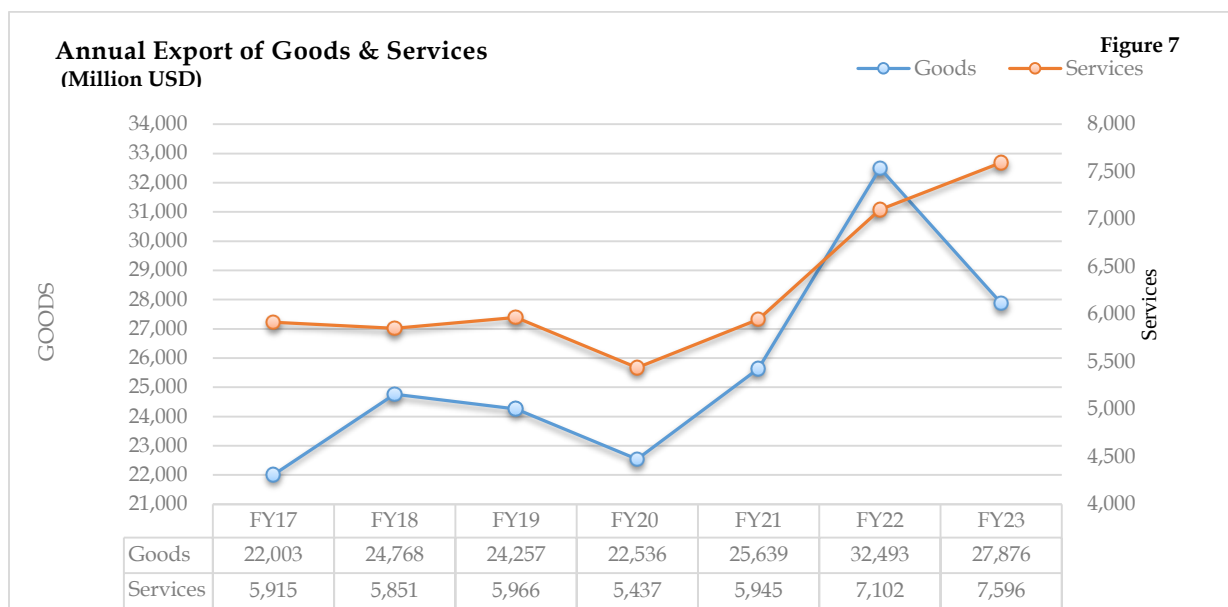
