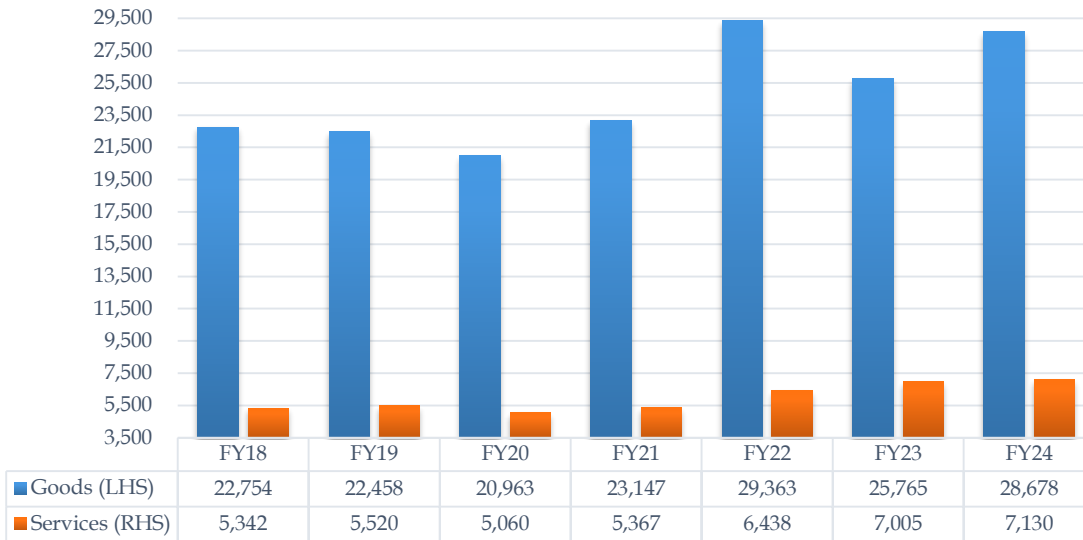

■ Services (RHS)

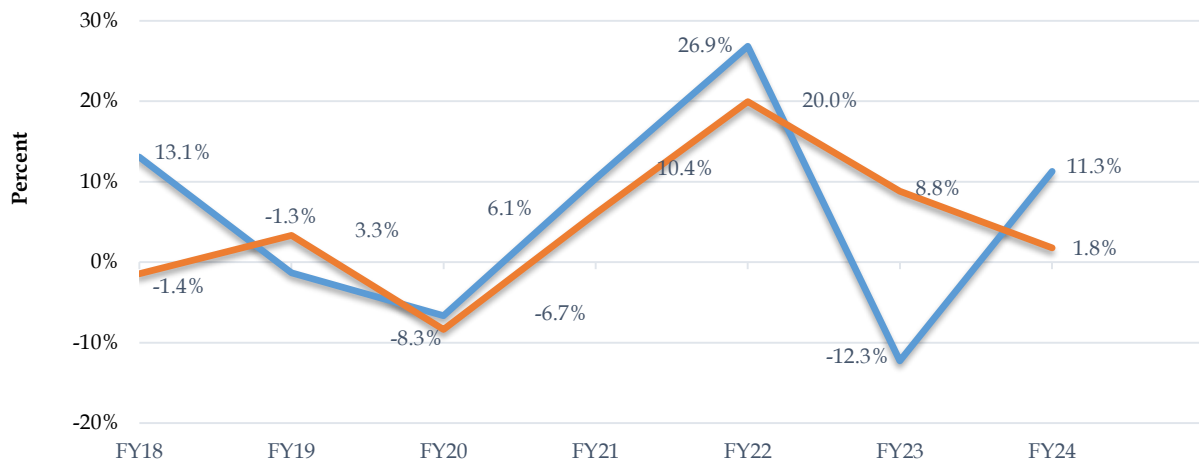


Growth in Export of Goods and Services during Jul-May

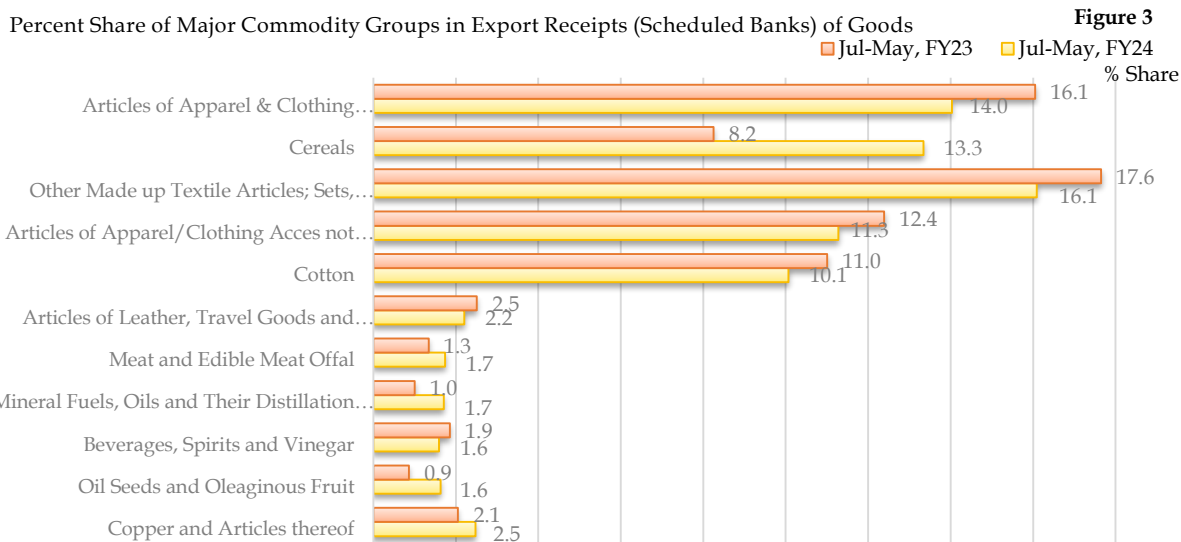

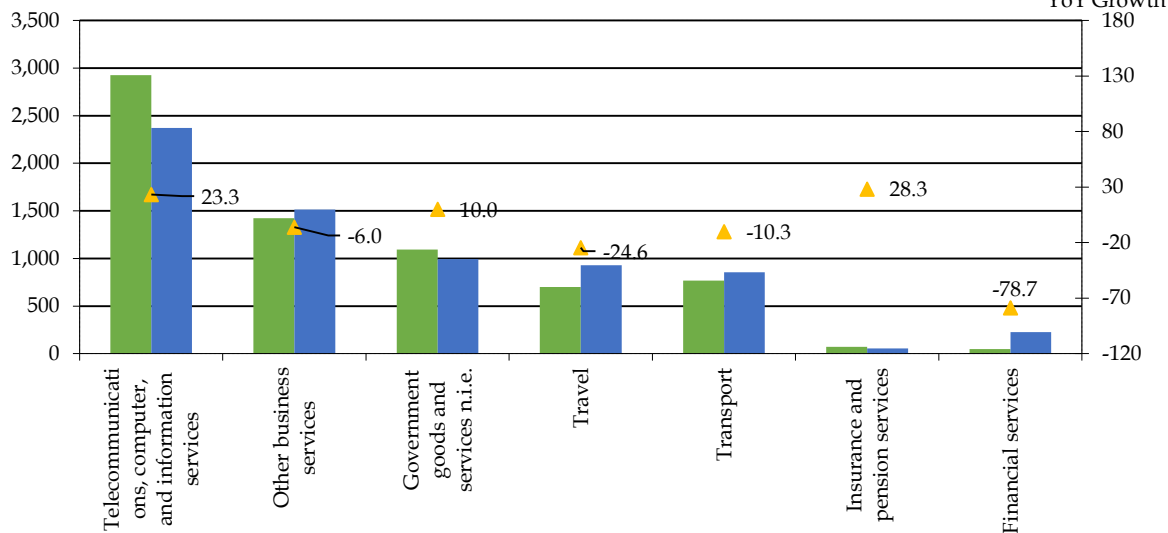

YoY Growth



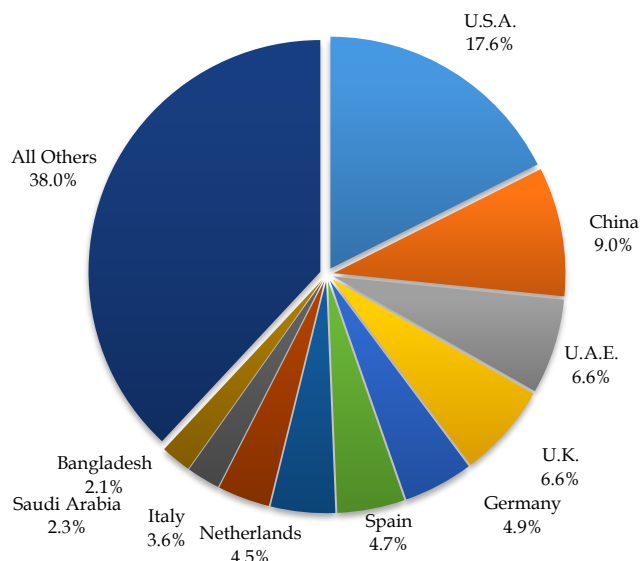

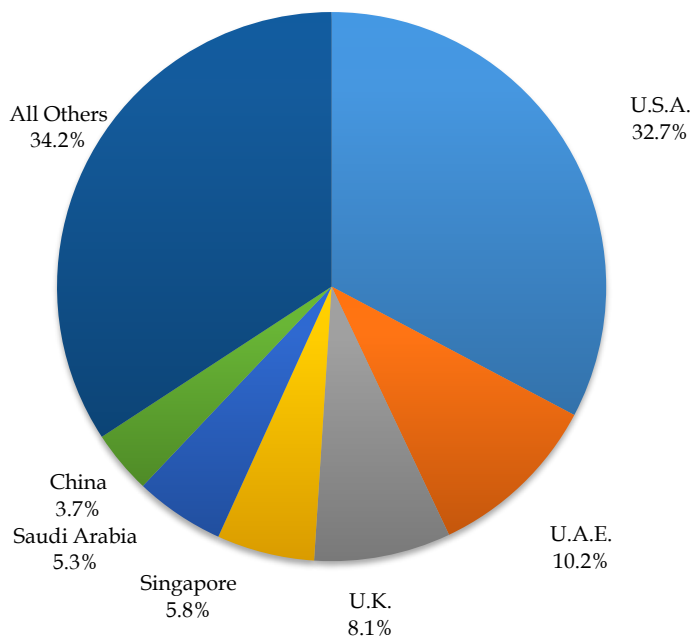
Percent share of Major Countries in Export Receipts of Goods during Jul-May, FY24

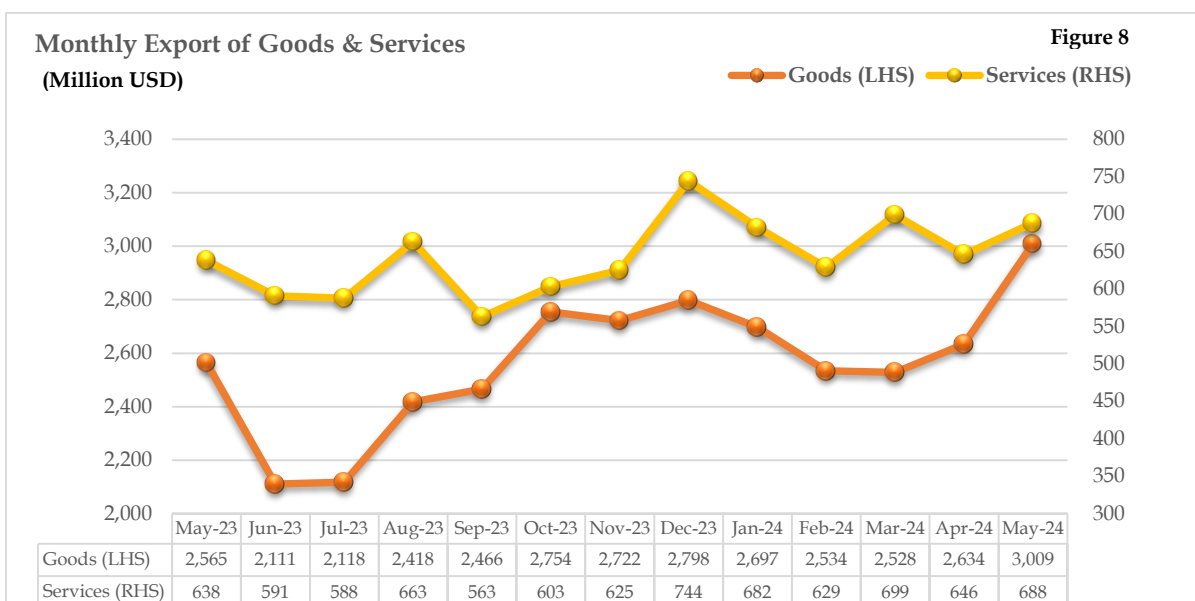
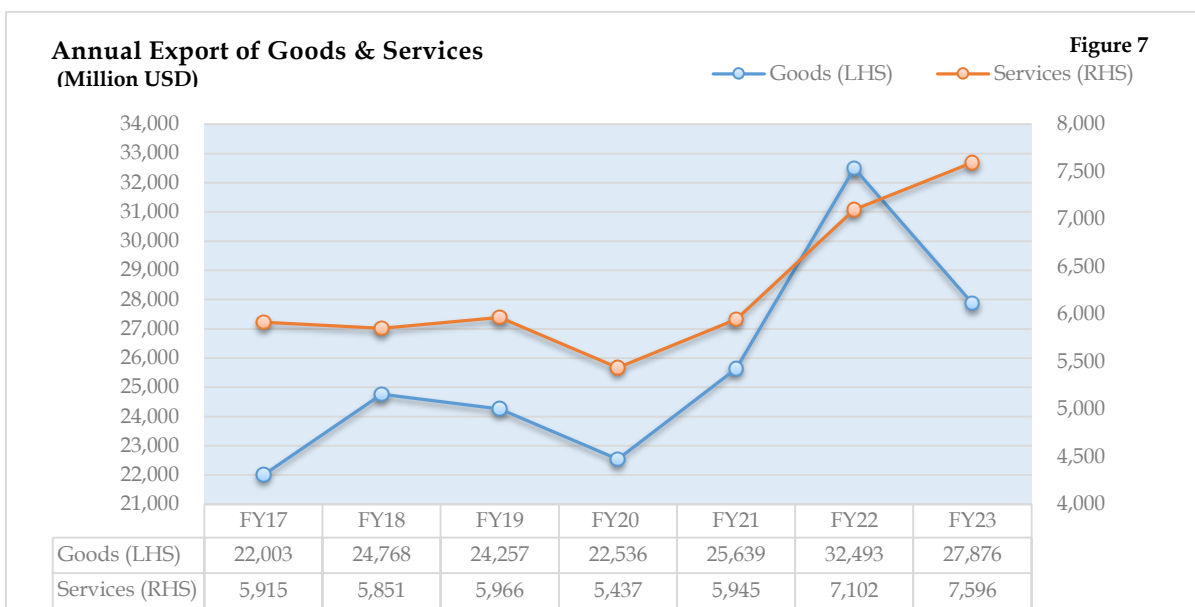
