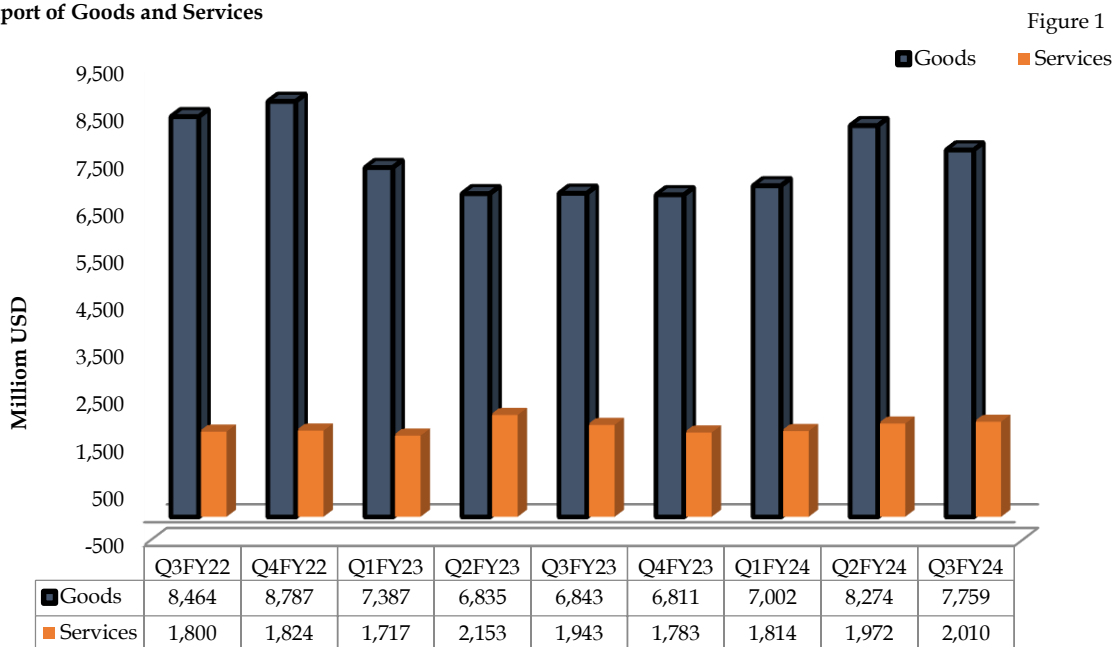

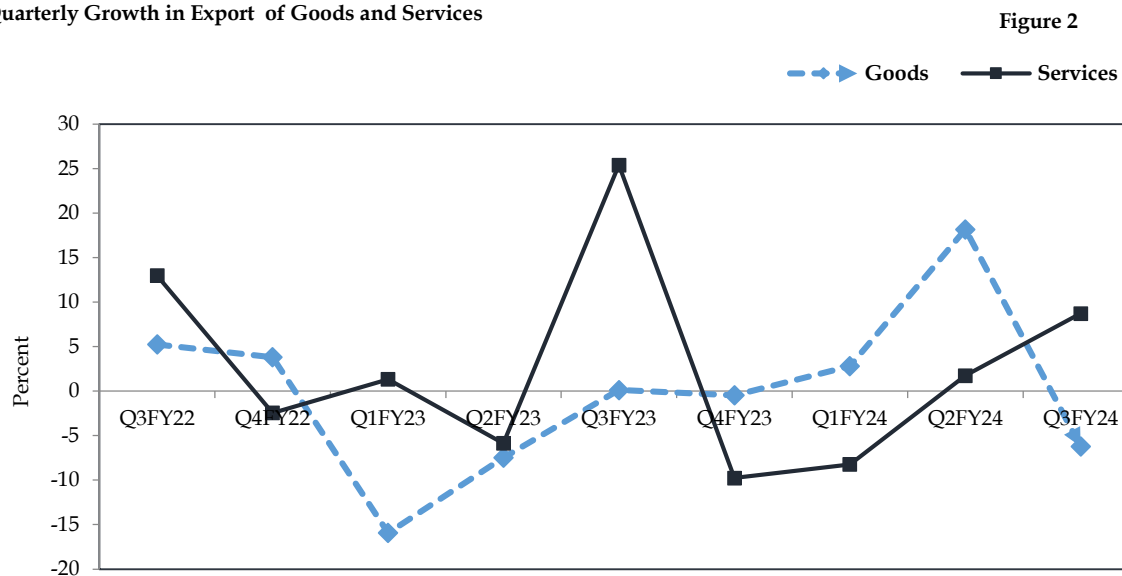

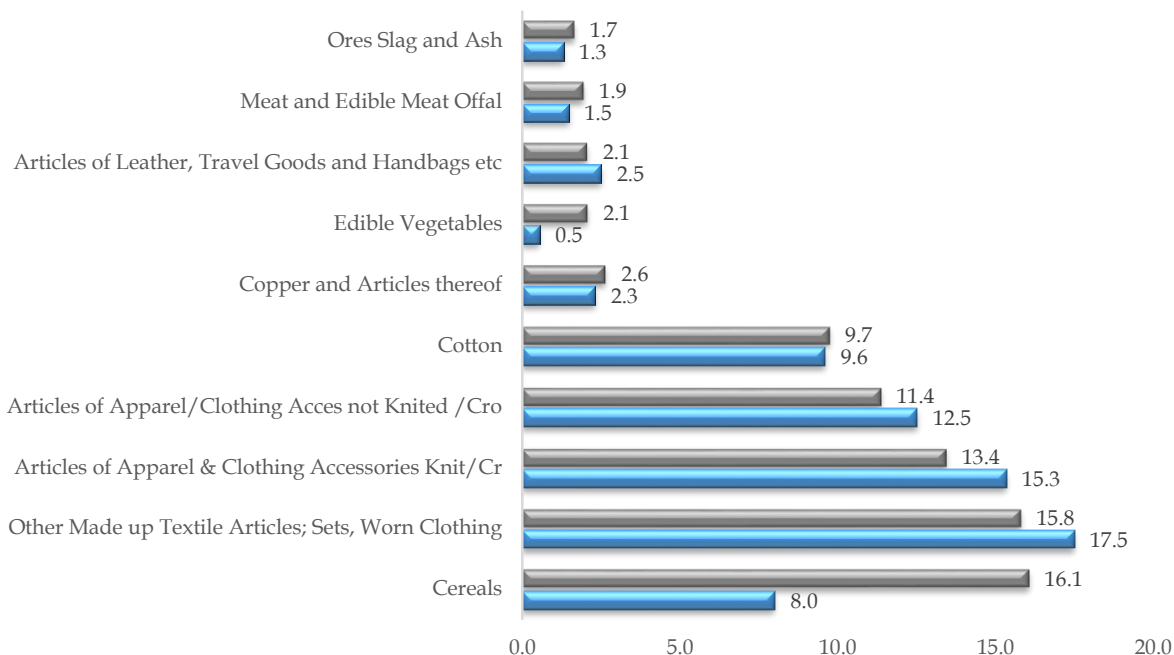

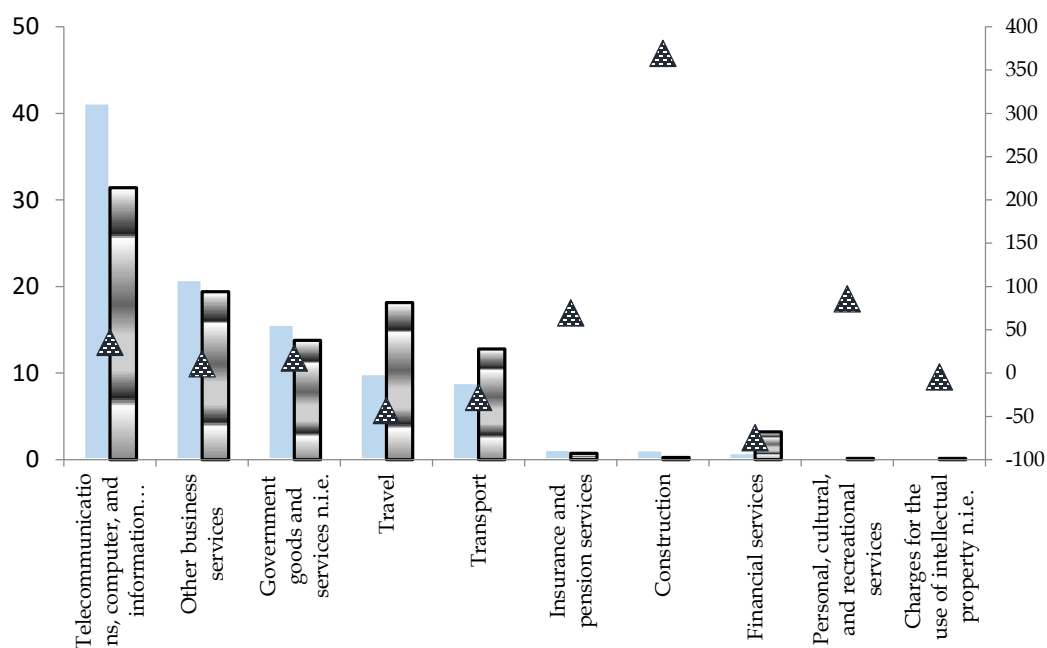
■ Q3FY24 ■ Q3FY23

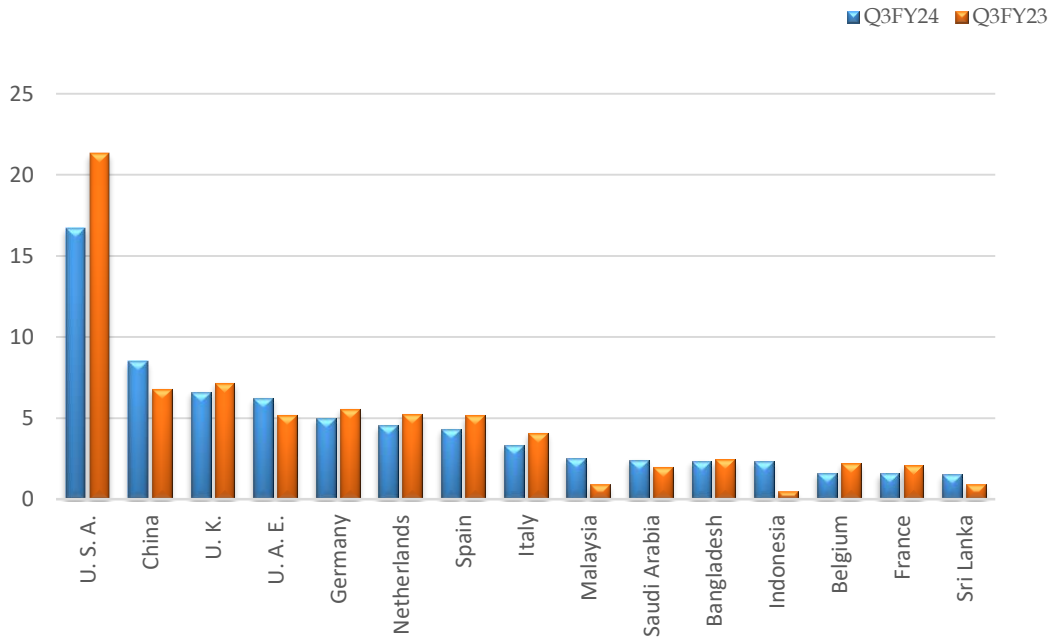

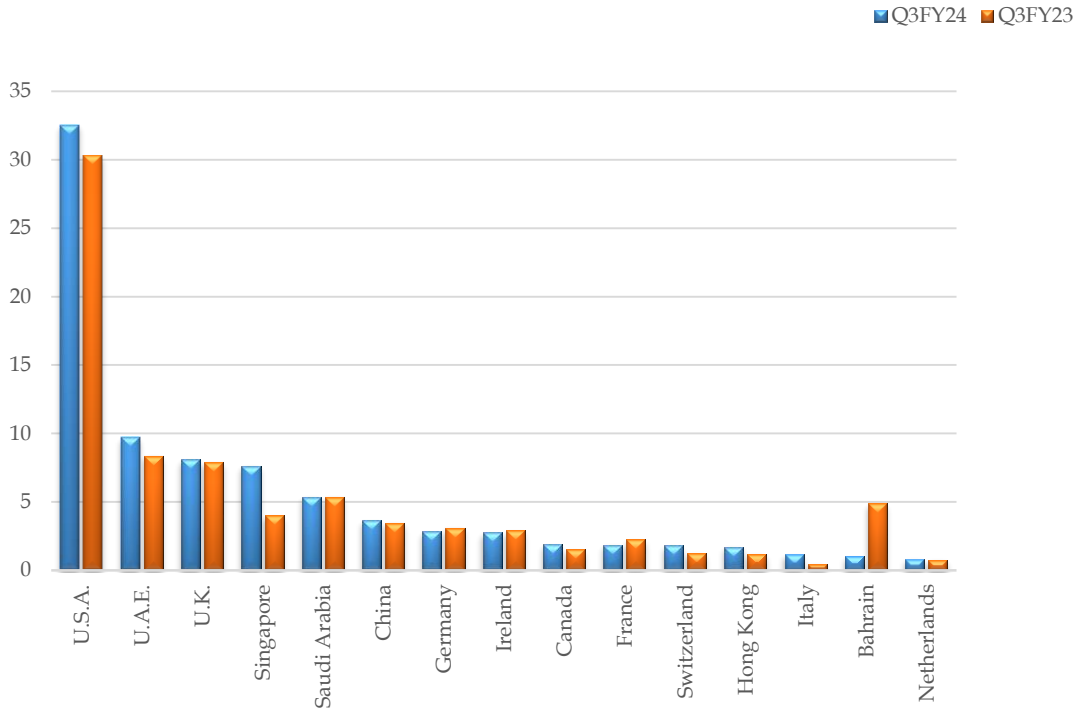
Percent Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts of Goods (Scheduled Banks)

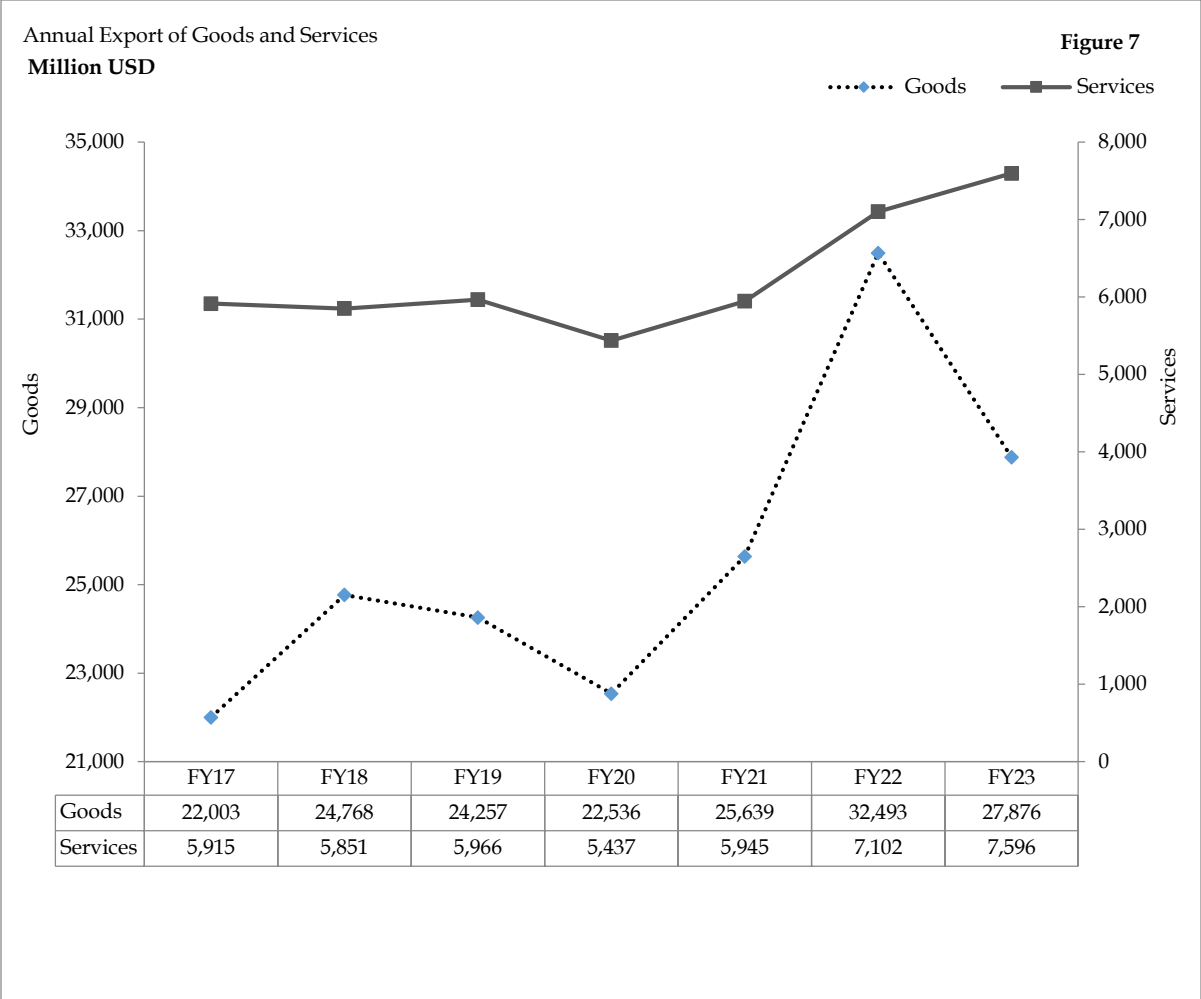
