Figure 1. Import of Goods and Services During Jul-Nov

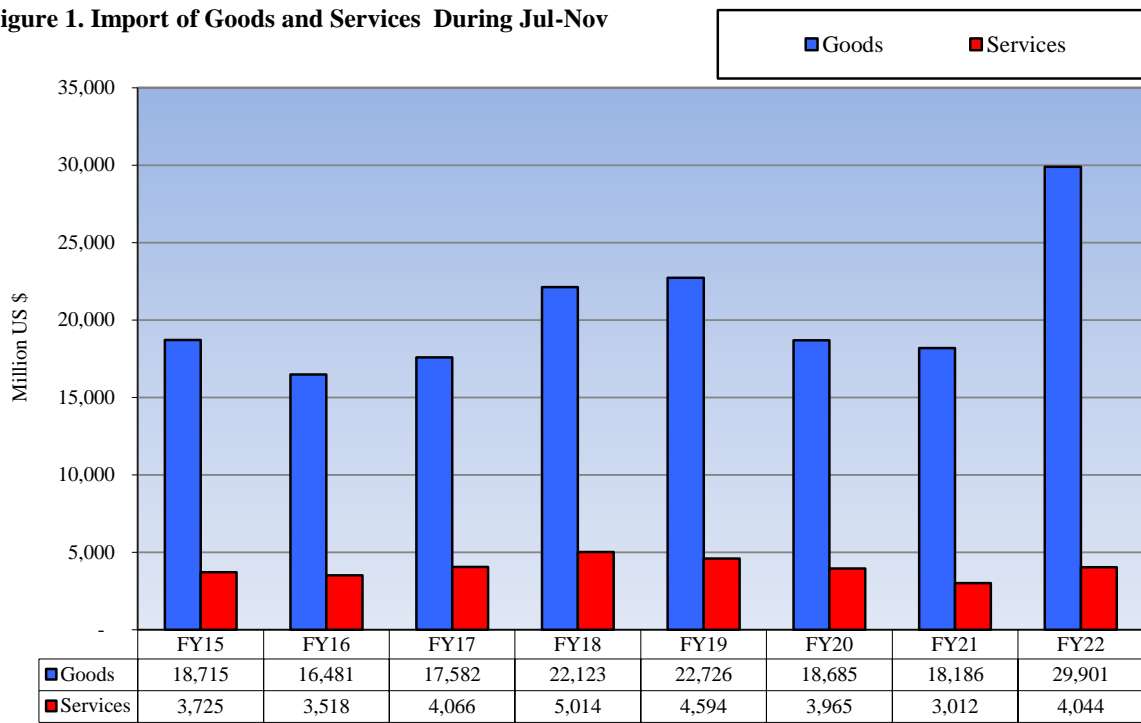


Figure 2: YOY Growth in Import of Goods & Services Jul-Nov

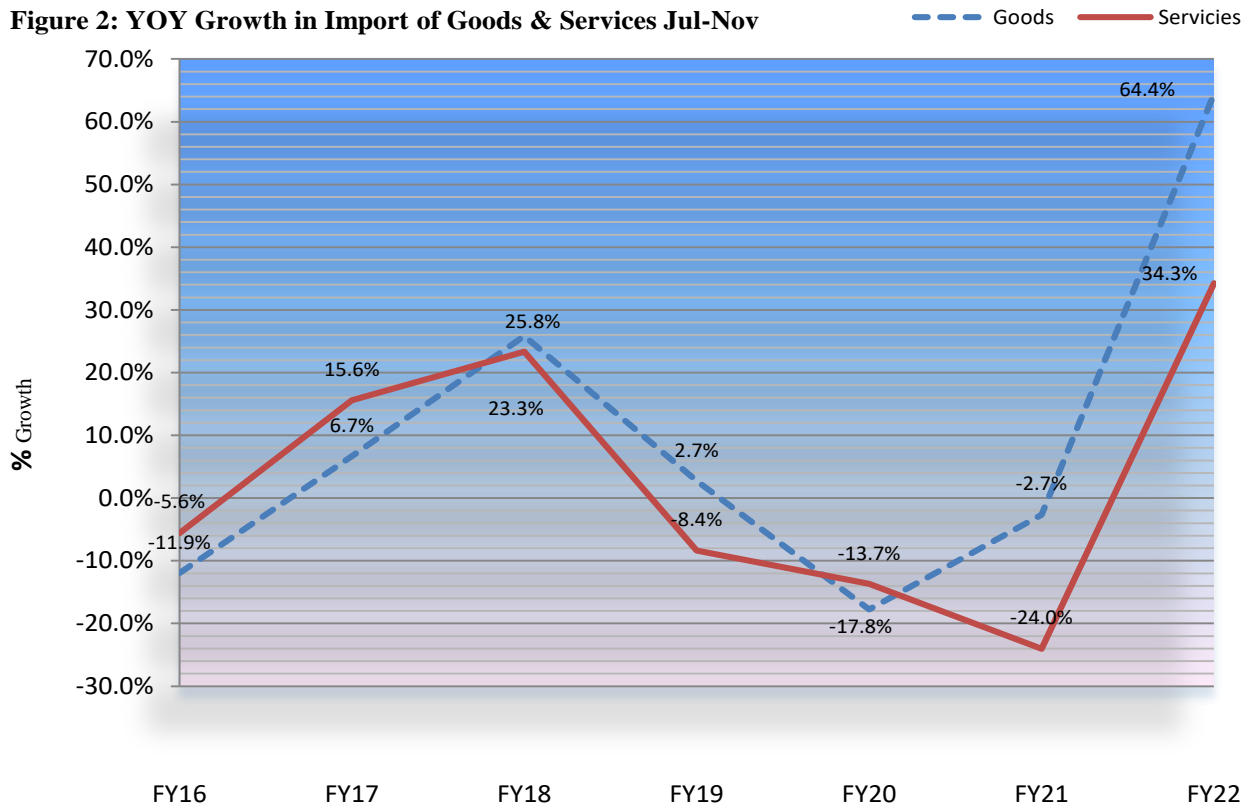

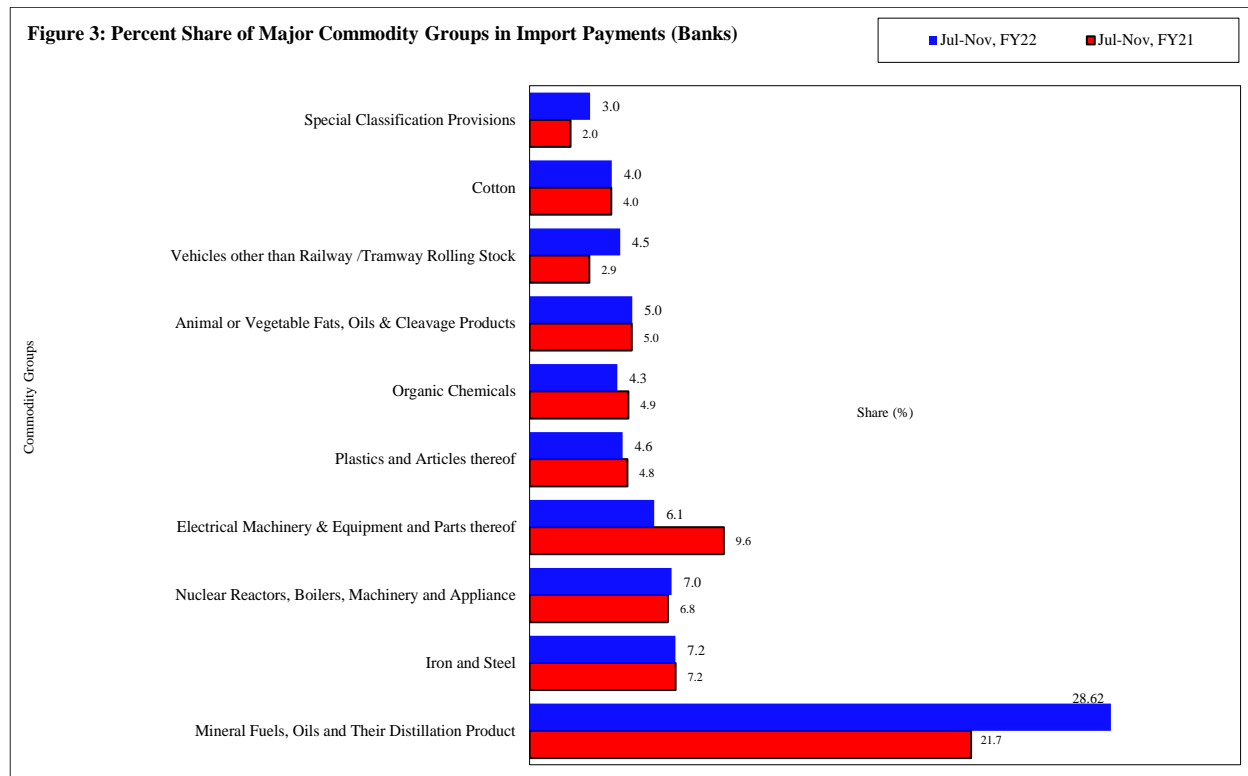

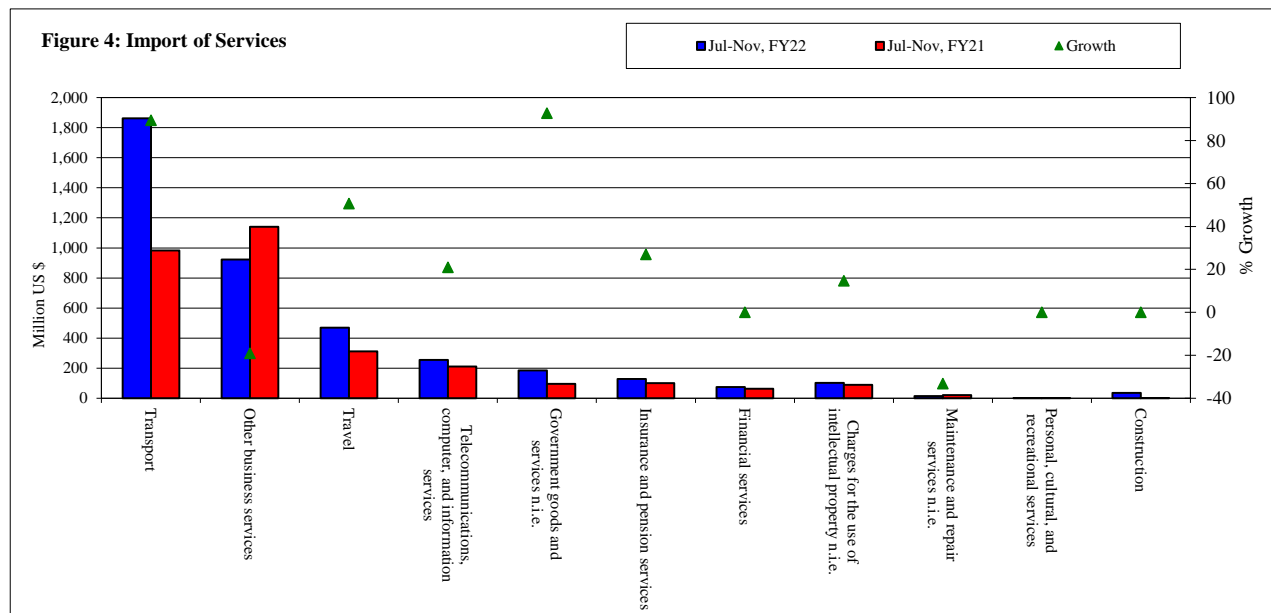
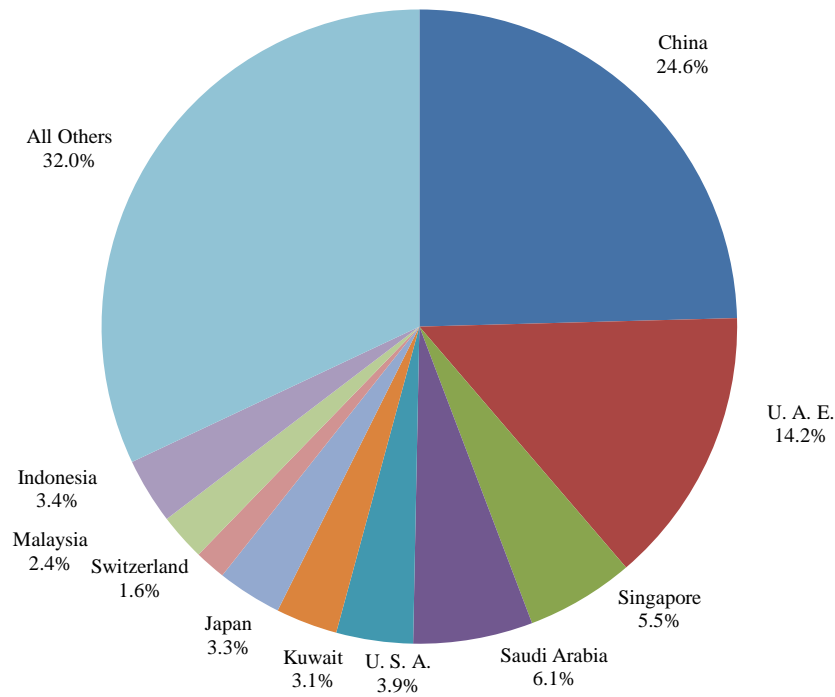
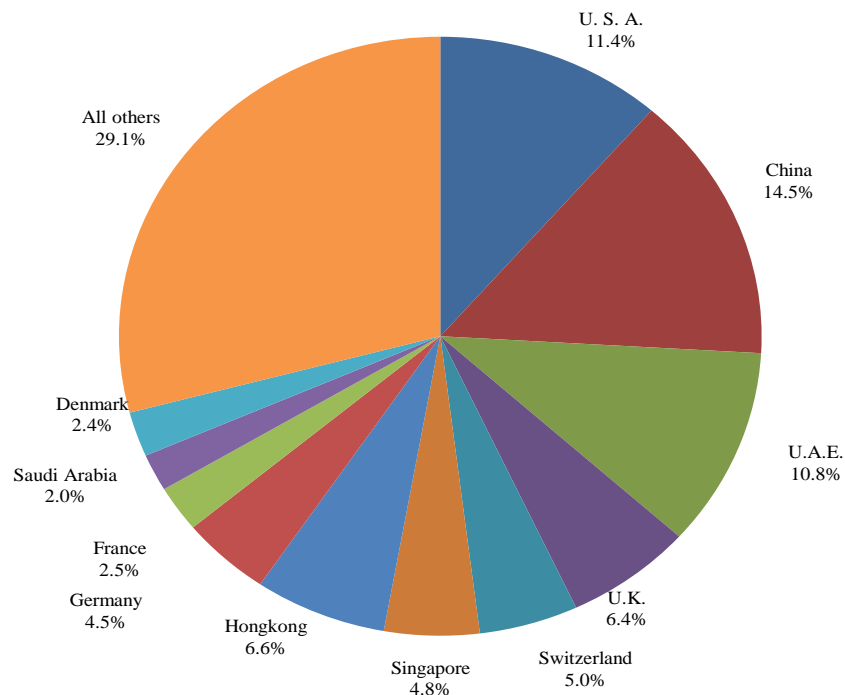


Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Import Payments of Goods During Jul-Nov, FY22

Figure 6: % Share of Major Countries in Import of Services During Jul-Nov, FY22



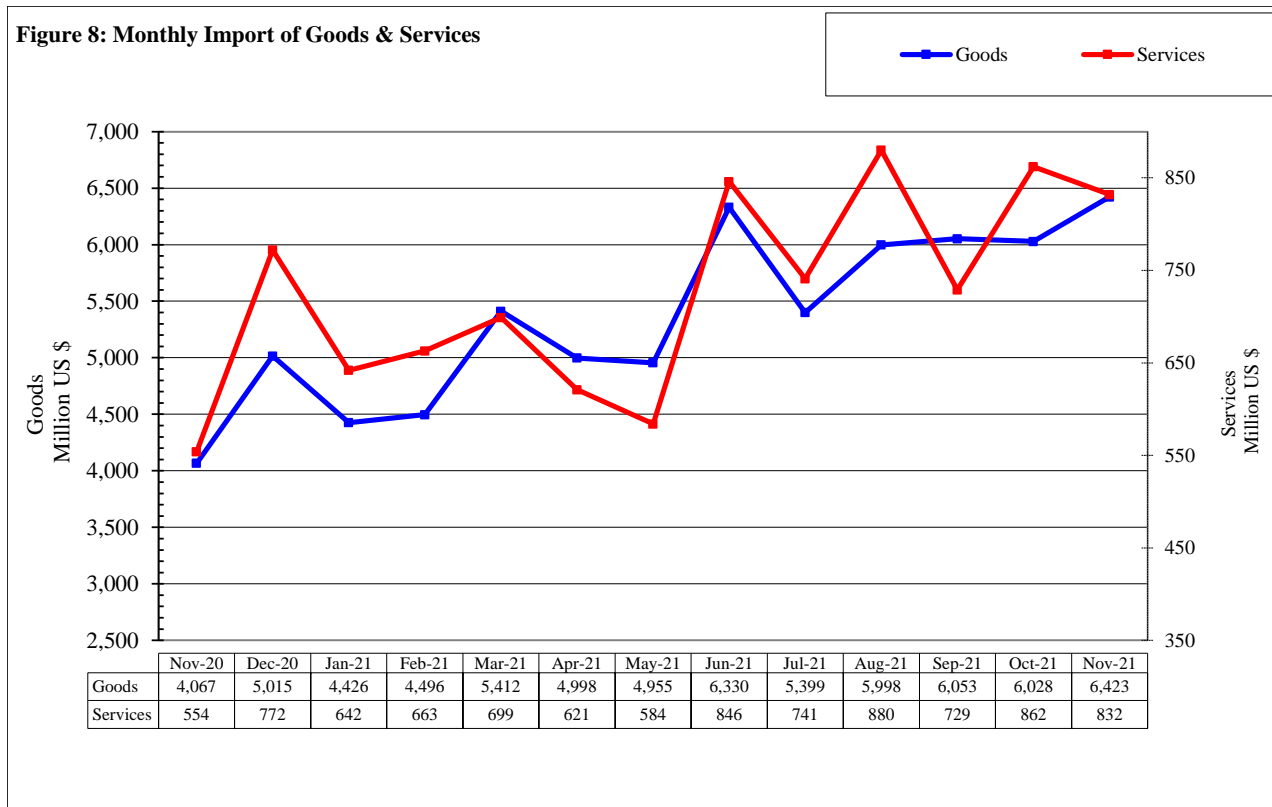
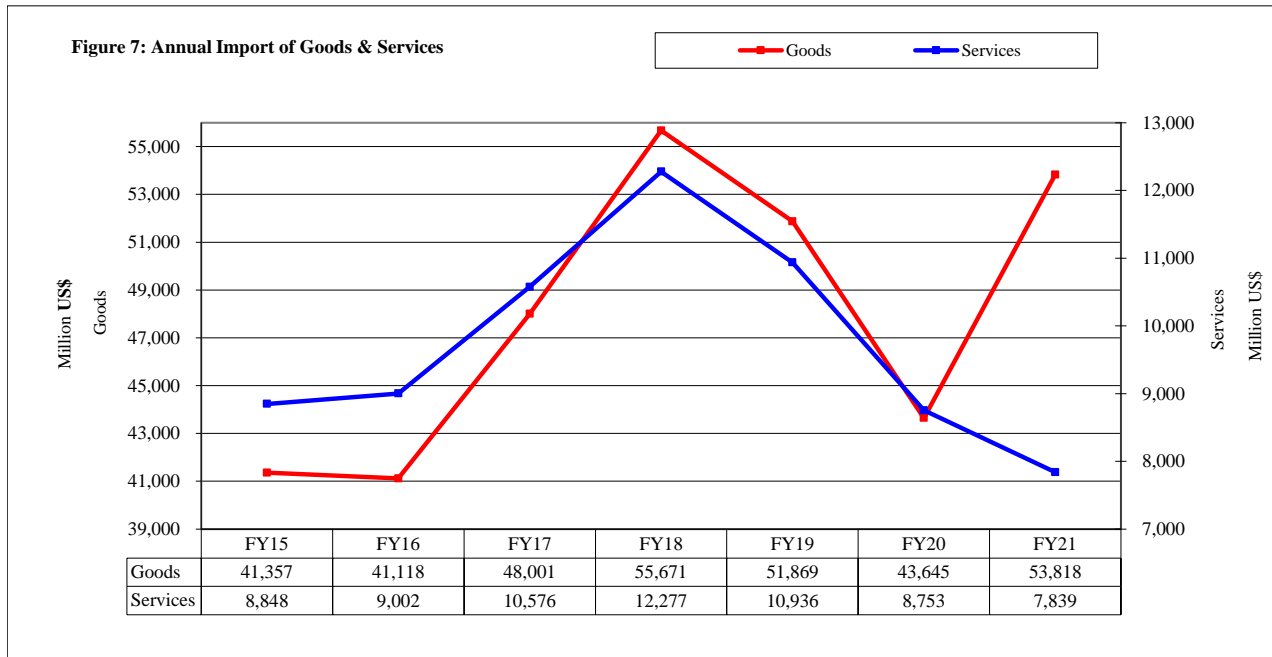
