

State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) collects, validates, compiles, disseminates, maintains and provides accurate, reliable and timely statistics for policy makers, researchers, academia and other national and international stakeholders. The Data Services and Innovations Department (DSID) at SBP provides reliable data to its users through modern platforms and statistical publications.

The non-financial sector is an important segment of a country's economy. SBP recognizes the importance of this sector's data for developing economic insights leading to optimal policy formulation. Accordingly, it prepares two publications i.e. Quarterly and Annual, which present the consolidated data of company-wise financial statements of the non-financial listed companies based on their quarterly and annual, un-audited/audited accounts respectively. In addition, each Annual publication provides a six-year data coverage in each edition, 2018-2023 in the current publication.

The companies covered in this publication are classified into economic groups based on the business activity described in their notes. The distribution is as under:
